

Emergency Reference Reminder

In the event of an emergency or disaster at your food service or food retail establishment, you must contact the Brimfield Board of Health (within one hour of the incident) if one or more of the following conditions occur at the your establishment. Per the terms of your permit to operate a Food Establishment, you are responsible for ensuring that all conditions set forth in the Massachusetts Food Code and Federal Food Code are followed regarding food safety.

- Fire
- Flood
- Raw Sewage Present
- Lack of Water
- Lack of Hot Water
- Lack of Restroom Facilities
- Contaminated Water
- Loss of Electricity or Gas
- Unapproved Food Handling
- Food Contamination
- Structural or Physical Building Defects
- Vermin Infestation
- Unsanitary Conditions
- Communicable Disease

If any of these conditions occur and remediation is not immediate, stop and call the Board of Health. Food Establishments cannot prepare (or sell) food without water service and without electricity or gas for temperature control.

Please note: Any modification or renovation to your facility, installation of new equipment, change of ownership or change of use requires a new modified application and submittal of plans and specifications to the Board of Health. Please contact the Board of Health with any questions.
